



Mid Georgia Ambulance Purchases Six New Ambulances

Mid Georgia Ambulance has recently replaced six of their ambulances with brand new models, keeping their total fleet at 39 ambulances. Each of the six new ambulances costs approximately \$100,000.00 unequipped. With the additional equipment costs of radios, GPS/AVL, medical supplies and other necessary equipment, the cost totals \$120,000.00

Each ambulance will be equipped with the latest in medical technology including new state of the art cardiac monitoring systems and digital mapping by way of the Automatic Vehicle Locator (AVL) and Global Positioning System (GPS) technology. The new ambulances will also have features that will increase their comfort, such as more leg room in the cab due to the ambulances being six inches longer than existing ambulances and a few inches taller.

The six new ambulances will be deployed as follows:

- Three to Columbus specifically for Muscogee Co
- Two to Macon/Bibb County
- One to the Pike and Lamar County operation

MGA is always in discussions with entities that are interested in outsourcing their ambulance business, because privatizing eliminates headaches and is more cost effective than operating the ambulances themselves. With more and more counties and hospitals opting for privatizing their EMS operations, Mid Georgia Ambulance will continue to grow and will continue to purchase the latest and most up to date equipment, including ambulances.
