The citizens of Pike County have a reason to feel safer at their County facilities. On January 6, Mid Georgia Ambulance presented two Automated External Defibrillators (AED) to the Pike County Commissioners for use at the Courthouse and the County Commission office.

Recently, Mid Georgia Ambulance donated two of these lifesaving AEDs to the Leadership Pike class for use by the recreation department. Stephen Marro, the Pike County Manager, saw a need for two more to have on hand at the Courthouse and the County Commission office.

“Pike County truly appreciates the donation of these AEDs for use at some of our county facilities and the recreation department. Mid Georgia Ambulance has already trained many of our employees in basic CPR with the use of AEDs, and now Mid Georgia Ambulance has stepped up and donated these AEDs for our employees to use in case of emergency. This is a tremendous benefit to the public and the employees of Pike County and we thank Mid Georgia Ambulance for their generous donation,” stated Stephen Marro, Pike County Manager.

These Automated External Defibrillators are smaller than a child’s lunch box and are used in conjunction with CPR. During early CPR, it analyzes the rhythm of the heart and automatically defibrillates if needed and then advises when the responder should continue CPR. If used in conjunction with CPR, an AED can greatly increase the chance of patient survival.
